## Salient Features

- ✓ In promoting excellent nursing practice, UTAR emphasises an extensive range of clinical practice. Students will be posted to government (Hospital Kuala Lumpur) and private healthcare settings on completion of the theoretical components.
- ✓ Nursing skills teachings and practices are conducted in simulation ward and skills laboratories equipped with simulation models such as Sim Man 3G and Harvey, SAM II and Guarnard baby prior to actual clinical placements in hospitals or clinics. This enables students to gain confidence and be well prepared before commencing their clinical placements.

They are qualified in the field of nursing and possess years of experiences in clinical, education, management and disciplinary related to nursing.
