Monash Global Campus Intensives (MGCIs) in Italy


Take Monash units at the Monash University Prato Centre in Italy with intensive study and local support during your winter or summer break. Credits from these units count towards your degree.

¹ As a Monash exchange student, you won't need to pay any additional tuition fees. However, your living and travel costs are not included in your fees, so you'll need to budget for them. Ensure that you have sufficient funds to cover your return airfare, visas, living expenses, and other necessities.


